Recruiting Duty can be challenging, but navigating your child's education should not. The ERR/WRR School Liaisons can answer questions you have about K-12 education matters.

Areas the School Liaison Can Address

- **Transition Services:** SLs can provide families with resources that help "level the playing field" for military children in K-12, while moving from school to school.
- **Home School Linkage:** SLs can share information on home schooling resources, policies, and legislation.
- **Resource & Referral:** SLs can provide information and refer families to other programs.
- **Post Secondary Preparation for High School Students:** SLs can provide families with graduating high school students information on post secondary opportunities.
- **Special Education:** SLs work in collaboration with EFMP to answer questions on educational matters.
