

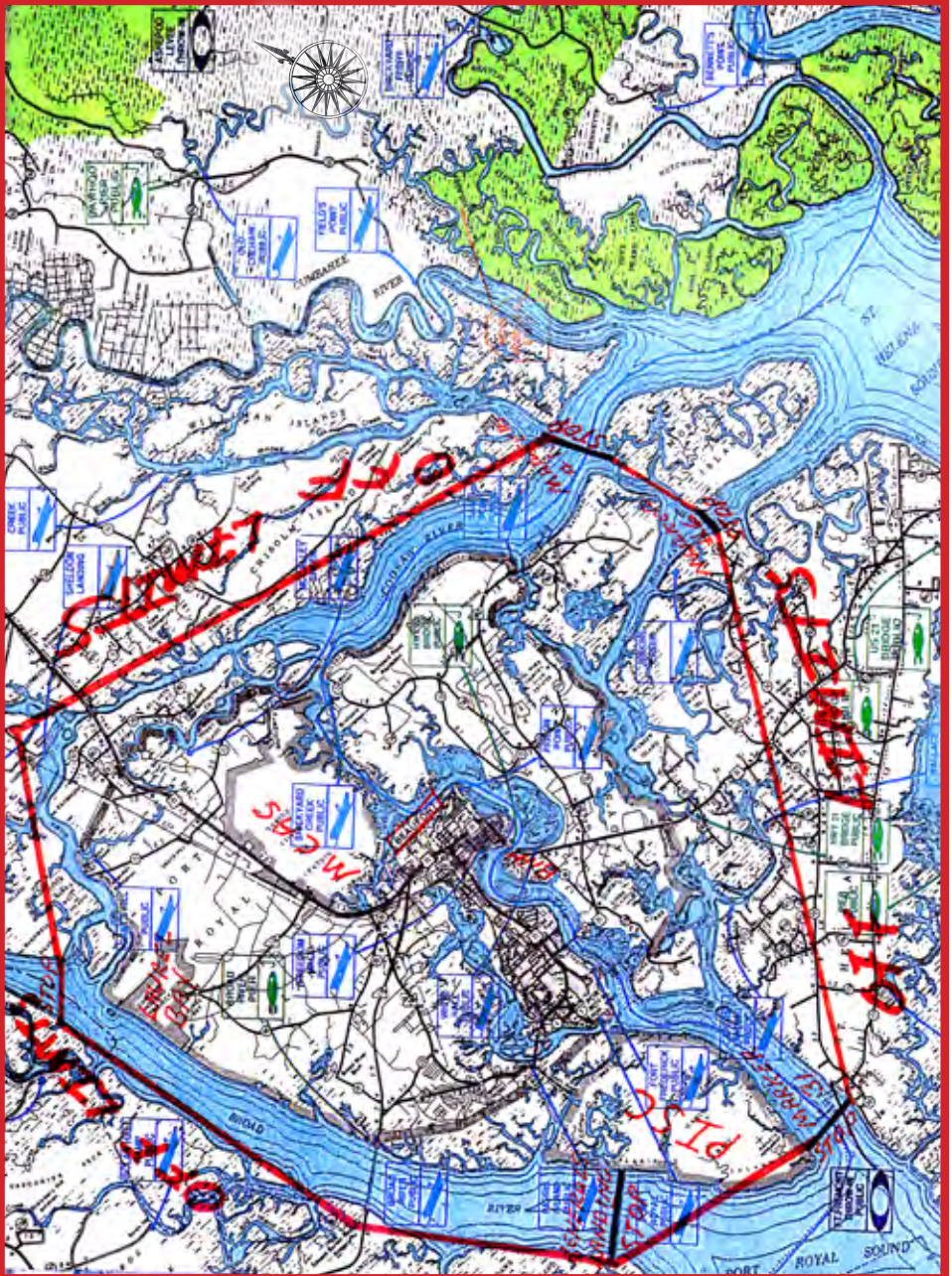

Rental Boat Rules & Regulations

Authorized Persons

You must be an authorized patron to rent any of this equipment. You will present a proper Department of Defense (DoD) identification, a valid MCCS SC boating permit card, and proof of automobile insurance.

You must be a responsible person age 18 years or older, in teams of two or more, to operate any MCCS SC rental boats. You may not operate any of our boating equipment as a solo operator.

Towing

The maximum highway towing speed for MCCS SC rental boats is 55mph. Boats may only be towed up to 125 miles away from MCAS Beaufort.

Boat Usage

You may not operate MCCS SC boat rental equipment before sunrise or after sunset.

PLEASE NOTE:

The use of any alcoholic beverages, drugs, or narcotics is strictly prohibited in connection with rental and operation of any MCCS SC boat or boating equipment.

All parties aboard MCCS SC rental boats should wear a personal flotation device (PFD). The operator of the boat must keep the safety lanyard attached to himself/herself at all times while operating the boat.

You must have a copy of the rental agreement on board with you at all times, according to state law of South Carolina. Please make sure you use common sense and discretion regarding your float plan in regard to weather conditions. You, a patron, are solely responsible for this boat rental equipment.

Return of Rental Equipment

You are responsible for returning all boat rental property to this facility. If you are late in returning this boat rental equipment, you will be charged a late fee.

PLEASE NOTE:

It is your responsibility to return this boat rental equipment in a clean condition, or you will be charged a cleaning fee. If any damage or loss occurs to any of this boat rental equipment while it is in your possession, you are responsible for paying for the repair or replacement of the damage done.

Capacity Permitted

The maximum capacity of persons permitted aboard MCCS SC boats is as follows:

14ft Carolina Skiff	2 persons
16ft Carolina Skiff	3 persons
15ft Boston Whaler	4 persons
17ft Boston Whaler.....	5 persons
17ft Carolina Skiff	5 persons
19ft Carolina Skiff.....	8 persons

- South of General's Landing on the Broad River
- Coosaw River & Morgan River
East of Coosaw & Morgan Islands
- Fripp Inlet
- St. Helena Sound

Cranking Procedures: Electric Start Engines

Side Mount Control Box

- 1** Lower the outboard motor to the run position. Make sure all the cooling water intake holes are submerged.
- 2** Open fuel tank vent screw (in filler cap) on manual venting type (6 gal.) fuel tanks.
- 3** Squeeze fuel line primer bulb several times until it feels firm.
- 4** Make sure the lanyard stop switch is in the run position.
- 5** Make sure the control handle is in the neutral position. ■

Side Mount Throttle/ Gear Control Handle

- 1** Lower the outboard motor to the run position. Make sure all the cooling water intake holes are submerged.
- 2** Squeeze fuel line primer bulb several times until it feels firm.
- 3** Make sure the lanyard stop switch is in the run position.
- 4** Make sure the control handle is in the neutral position. ■
